Summary of Activities

- Address the Perkins V core indicators of performance, including:
 - % of CTE concentrators who remain enrolled, progress to advanced training or are placed into employment, apprenticeship, or the military
 - % of CTE concentrators who receive a recognized credential in within 1 year of program completion
 - % of CTE concentrators in CTE programs that lead to non-traditional fields. Student qualifies if individuals from their gender comprise less than 25% of the individuals employed in the related occupation or field of work.
- Projects include equipment, supplies, and/or staffing support for graphic art and design, CTE counseling, CTE marketing, career services, and professional development for CTE faculty/staff.

Highlights & Accomplishments

- Upgrade equipment in the Graphic Art and Design program to industry standard.
- Began a bilingual radio campaign to promote CTE programs.
- Provide dedicated funding for a counselor to focus on the re-entry population.
- Provide funds for CTE student Ambassadors and a CTE Data Technician.
- Fund professional development for CTE faculty, staff and management.
- Fund partial salaries and benefits for three support staff in the Grants, IR dept.
