VETERANS ENROLLMENT CHECKLIST

Step 1: Apply for Veteran Education Benefits

If you are utilizing your veterans or dependent of a veteran education benefits for the first time, you must **submit your application for benefits to the VA**. You will receive a certificate of eligibility in the mail from the VA once your application has been processed (approximately 30 days).

Step 2: Begin the enrollment process at Cuesta College

- 1. Complete the **online application** to apply to Cuesta College
- Please check with Admissions and Records if your residency is determined to be out of state. With AB
 540 and/or AB13 VACA, you may be eligible for in state tuition. There are deadlines for residency. For more

- 3. Apply for Financial Aid
- 4. Complete the **online orientation**
- 5. In order to secure **priority registration**, submit a copy of your DD-214 form to **veterans@cuesta.edu**
- 6. To view your priority date/time to register, <u>login to myCuesta</u> go to the Student tab, Steps to Success channel, and click on "Check Registration Status".

Step 3: Request all Military and School Transcripts MILITARY TRANSCRIPTS:

Request official military transcripts to be sent to the Cuesta College Admissions and Records Office via the following sites:

- Air Force: Complete the **USAF Transcript Request Form** and mail it to the address shown on the form.
- Army, Coast Guard, Marines, and Navy: <u>Submit your request electronically</u>
 (Note: if you get the message "Your connection is not private", click on the link that says "ADVANCED"
 and then click on "proceed to jst.doded.mil/smart/welcome.do")

SCHOOL TRANSCRIPTS:

<u>Request official transcripts</u> of all previous college enrollment to be sent to the Cuesta College Admissions and Records office.

Step 4: Complete your Student Education Plan (SEP)

<u>Make an appointment</u> to see a counselor who will help you create a Student Education Plan (SEP). Be sure to ask about Math and English placement.

- Are you a returning student within 1 year?

- Have the same Degree Plan as last semester?
