Fabulous facts about the Academic Senate:

- The Academic Senate is empowered by law to make recommendations on academic and professional matters. This power includes policy development with respect to curriculum, degree and certificate requirements, grading, educational programs, student preparation and success, faculty roles in college governance structures, faculty roles and involvement in the accreditation process, faculty professional development activities, program review processes, institutional planning and budget development.
- All Cuesta College faculty are members with representation on the Academic Senate.
- The Academic Senate Council is the legislative body that acts on behalf of all faculty concerning professional and academic matters.
- The Academic Senate Council consists of the Academic Senate President (Alexandra Kahane), the Academic Senate Vice President (Fionnuala Butler), one Senator representative from each division selected by divisional faculty, the Chair of the Curriculum Committee (Steve Leone/Matt Knudsen), and three at-large Senator representatives. In addition, a representative from Cuesta College Federation of Teachers (CCFT President Greg Baxley), a representative from Associated Students of Cuesta College, and the Secretary of the Academic Senate are non-voting members of the Academic Senate Council.
