WHAT IS DUAL ENROLLMENT/CCAP?

Dual Enrollment is an opportunity for high school students to be enrolled with your high school and with Cuesta College at the same time! Enrollment fees are waived as a dual enrollment student with Cuesta College.

PROGRAMS AT CUESTA COLLEGE:

1. Enrichment Program:

- Attend Cuesta College in person or online, outside of your high school day
- Enrollment fees are waived

2. College and Career Access Pathways (CCAP) Program

- Attend Cuesta College during your regular high school day in your high school period
- Receive both high school and college credit for one high school period
- All student fees are waived (enrollment fees, campus fees, and all instructional materials including textbooks)
